Saturday, September 4 thru Monday, September 6

FootFall will take place over Labor Day weekend at beautiful Camp Louise in Cascade, Maryland (near the Pennsylvania/Maryland border). FootFall begins on Saturday, September 4 and runs through Monday, September 6, 2021. Yes, you read that right. We hate bumper-to-bumper, emission-exuding DC-area Friday night holiday traffic, so FootFall check-in is Saturday morning at 10 am. Pack the car Friday night, go to bed early, and then arrive on Saturday morning in the doublet * morning, in the daylight.

FootFall shares space and meals with World Village Music and Dance Camp. All attendees at either event may attend any workshop. World Village features Greek and Balkan dance (and will host the balfolk sessions); Georgian, Bulgarian, and Ukranian singing; and Bulgarian and Pontic lyra instrument workshops. Workshop times will be coordinated to facilitate crossover. Again this year the Sunday night dance will feature all of the dance and music genres, with everyone from both camps participating.
